- Please be sure that you meet the qualifications of the scholarships that you check off.
- Please be sure that all supportive forms are included with each application.
- Applications are due in the Counseling Office by March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024. This deadline will be adhered to strictly! All supporting documents must be included.

## **Supporting Documents Include:**

- 1. Copy of High School Transcript (or college for post-graduates)
- 2. Copy of SAT/ACT scores from College Board or from transcript
- 3. True copies of the parent & the student 1040 Federal tax Forms \* You do not need to include supporting documents just the 1040 is required. State returns are not needed.
- 4. Copies of the W-2 Tax Forms for the parent & student. \*
- 5. Complete the FAFSA and attach the summary sheet showing your Expected Family Contribution (EFC)

Shirley G. Reese Memorial Scholarship	Awarded to a graduating senior who might not otherwise be able to attend a four-year-college
