

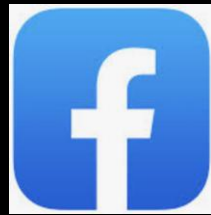

- Any issue will be addressed by staff in the classroom & then Administration if needed

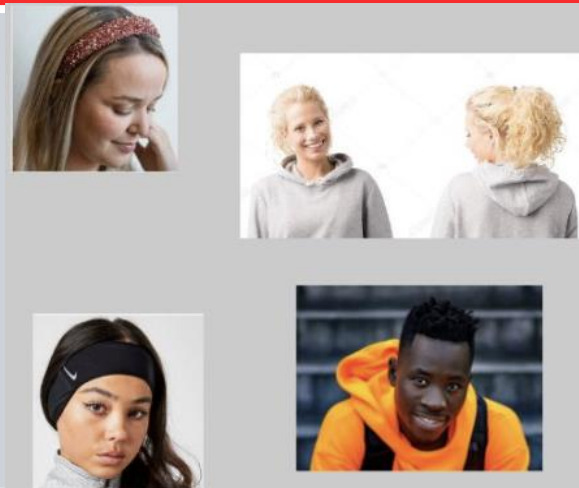

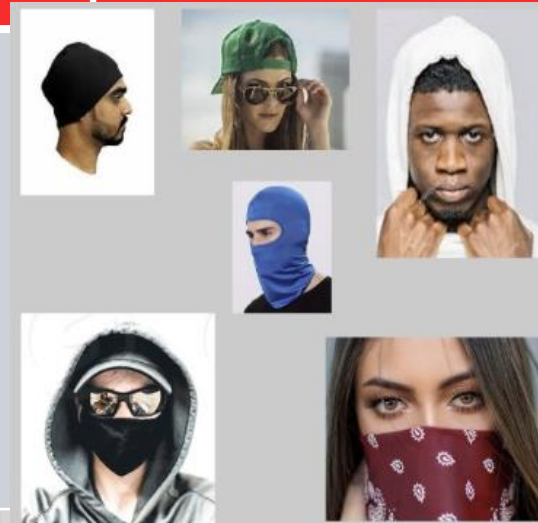
No Sunglasses, ski masks, beanies, hats, visors, hoods, bandanas, or other head gear.

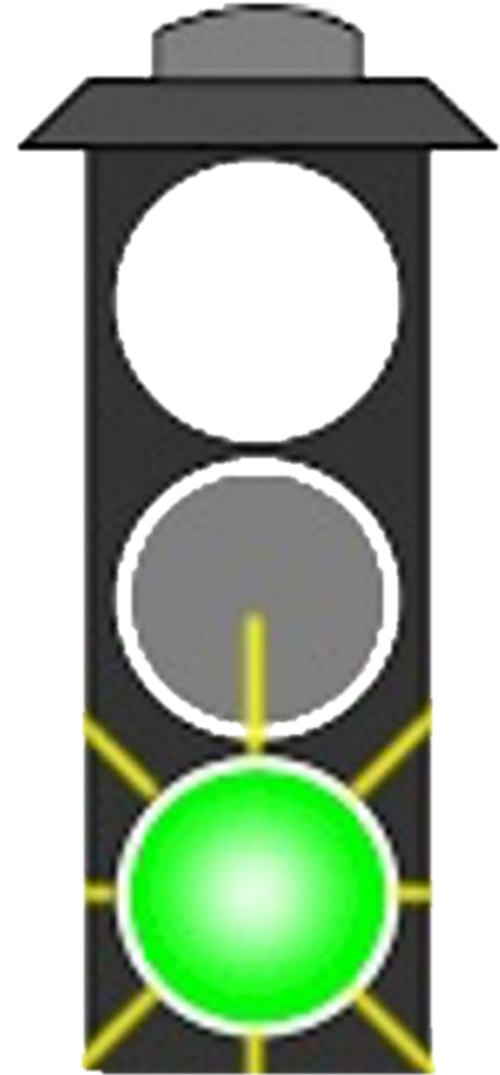

Green zone areas include the cafeteria, commons before and after school, hallways during class changes, bus, before and after school, and extracurricular activities.



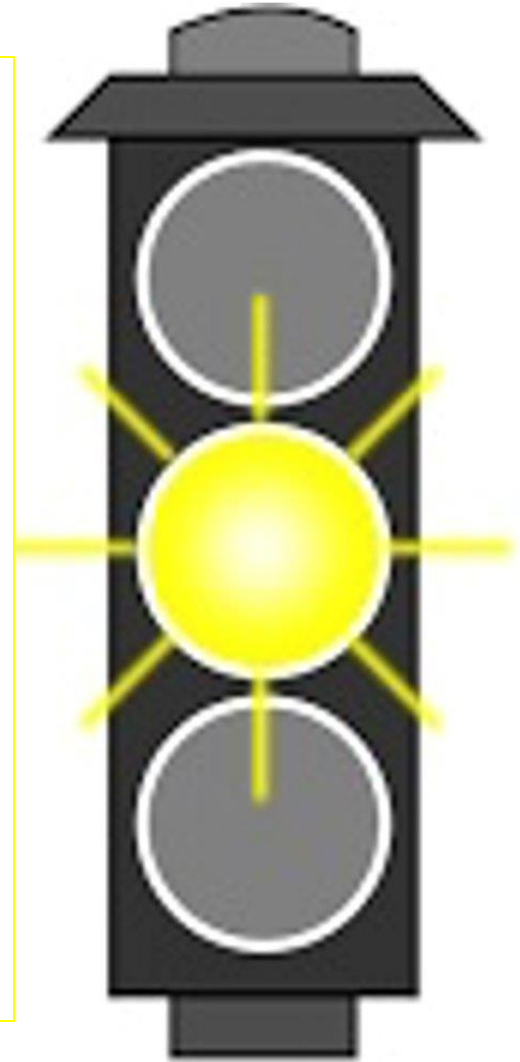
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YELLOW ZONE

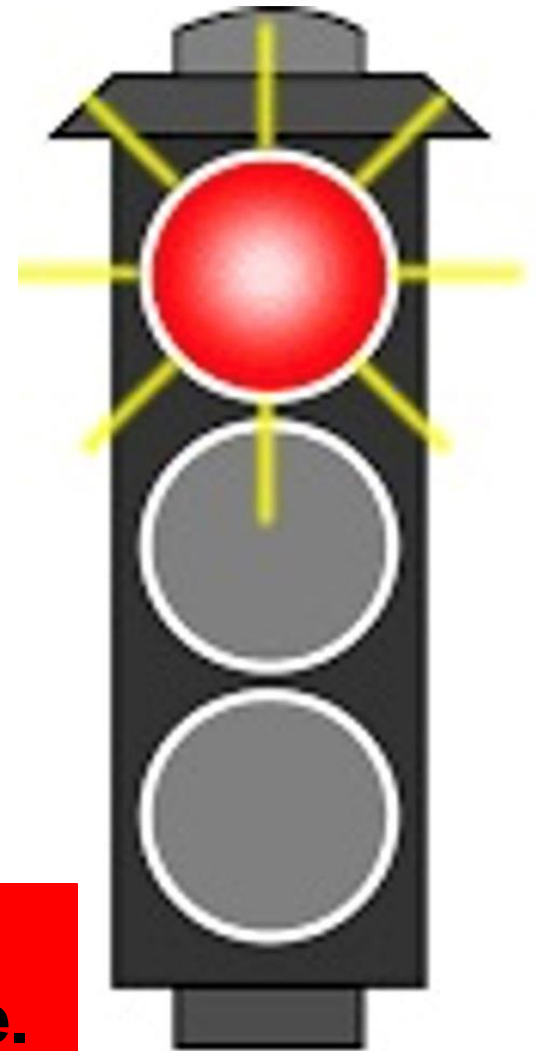
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RED ZONE
